2010 League Play Agreement

Welcome to the 2010 EWGA (Syracuse) Golf Season. To ensure an enjoyable golf season for all, below you will find some guidelines to keep in mind.

Subs

Should you not be able to make your scheduled round of league play, in Leagueboss and distributed at orientation will be a listing of players to contact for subbing. Once a sub is found, please email both your League Captain and playing partner your sub's information.

Timeliness and Tee Times

To ensure all league players play their rounds during daylight hours, we can not stress enough the responsibility of being on the tee box and ready to golf at your appropriate tee time; we all know things can occasionally happen, so if you or someone in your group is running late, we ask that you still tee off at your designated tee time. A course ranger will take you out to meet your foursome where play will resume on the next tee box. There are many ladies to play behind and everyone wants to finish during daylight hours. **DO NOT WAIT** and play out of your assigned tee times.

Double Par Pick Up

Another way we keep the round going is by utilizing double par pick up. The maximum number of strokes for a par 3 is 6, par 4 is 8, and par 5 is 10. Any player having a score higher than those mentioned, the ball is to be picked up and the hole X'd out on the scorecard. First player out, is the flag attendant thus ensuring movement on the hole.

Accurate Scoring

When your round is complete, scorecards should be compared to ensure that the scores being turned in reflect the same scores you recorded on the course on your scorecard. Please make sure a score is entered for each hole. When finished reviewing cards, sign the scorecard and turn the card in to your League Captain.

Rain Dates

We will make every effort to play golf and do not cancel due to rain. The only person to cancel golf is the League Captain; this will be done by 3pm on the day of play, otherwise, please report to the course. Each League Captain will be in touch with the Course and advise the League accordingly. Should there be a Rain Day, it will be added on to the end of the 16 week schedule.

Please check the box on the front of your registration that the Agreement has been read, sign and date.
